- The President asked how the token gifts were delivered to School Board Members for Haitian Flag Day. Gifts are usually delivered on the day of the School Board's monthly meeting. Yverose usually planned with Carl Nicoleau, so she could place the gift bags at each the Board member's seat (before start of meeting)
- Scholarship: Ms. Viard proposed we form a scholarship subcommittee. We could give a yearly scholarship, and every year, name it after one of the founding fathers of the organization. She will work with Bertrand to gain more knowledge of the association's early days.
